

Back to Basics – Healing is Already Ours

Overview: Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection secured for us an amazing salvation package. It includes not only our spiritual regeneration but healing for our bodies, and so much more. Jesus has already done it, we are not trying to get God to heal us, but by faith we are walking out our healing until we see the manifestation.

A. Healing Is Already Ours

1. The Partnership – What Jesus has done.
 - a. The Story of Healing.
 - The Messiah would bear our infirmities. Isa 53:4-5
 - He healed all to fulfill the Isaiah prophecy. Mat 8:16-17
 - By His stripes (wounds) we were healed. 1 Pet 2:24
 - b. All the promises belong to us through inheritance. Rom 8:16-17
 - c. All Scripture is inspired by God (God breathed). 2 Tim 3:16
 - d. It is impossible for God to lie. Heb 6:18
2. The Partnership – What we do.
 - a. Believe the things we say without doubting in our heart. Mark 11:23
 - b. Believe that we have received when we pray. Mark 11:24
 - c. Abraham believed God, accounted as righteousness. Rom 4:3; 18-22
 - d. As thou has believed, so shall it be done unto you. Matt 8:13
 - e. All things are possible to them that believe. Mark 9:23

B. Walking Out Our Healing

1. The Key – release the anointing. Mar 16:20; Joh 7:37-39
2. Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Heb 11:1
3. Faith without works is dead, believing adds the works. Jam 2:17-26
4. What does faith (believing) look like? It is seen in our thoughts, attitudes, and ultimately, in our words and actions.
 - Thoughts – bring every thought captive to Christ. 2 Cor 10:5
 - Attitudes – I will win, no matter what. Healing is mine. Matt 11:12
 - Words – life is in the power of the tongue. Speak the Word. Pro 18:21
 - Actions – Act on the Word you know. Faith that works. Jam 2:22
5. Believing the Word in your heart leads to complete salvation. Luke 8:12
6. I believe; therefore I have spoken. 2 Cor 4:13
7. These signs shall follow them that believe. Mar 16:17
